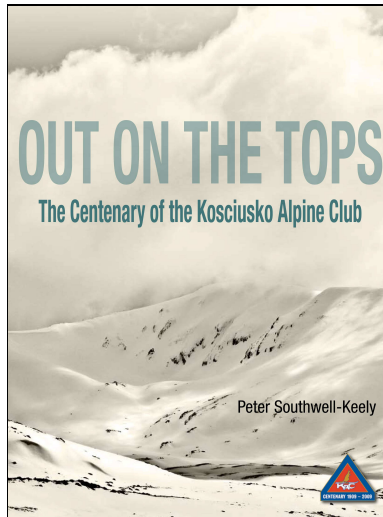


KAC Centenary Book
