

School Holiday Ballot
WINTER 2010
Applications Close Friday February 12th at 5pm

BALLOT REGULATIONS:

Each year, accommodation for the school holidays is allocated by ballot. Accommodation is for seven (7) days only.

Spouses who only require accommodation on Friday and Saturday cannot be included.

Preference is given to children who are Junior Members of the Club. Only children who are Junior members of the Club are eligible for the first ballot. (The ballot is determined by Junior Membership, not Senior Membership.)

One application per junior member is permitted.

The second ballot is held for children who are not members but whose parents are members. The procedure is carried out under the scrutiny of a Justice of the Peace. A Waiting List is maintained from the ballot results.

Should there be insufficient places in the first ballot for the number seeking accommodation, then those juniors receive preference the following year, even if they eventually receive a cancellation i.e. if an offer is not made for an allocation of beds in any of the three lodges during the three weeks of the school holidays. There has been no need to utilise this rule for many years.

You will be offered one week out of the three, although it may not be your first preference. If you want extra time or accommodation for an additional non-member friend, please make a note on your application *in case* there are last minute cancellations. Clearly itemise any special requirements on your booking application form and send it to the Registered Office:

The closing date is Friday, February 12th, 2010 at 5pm.

Late applications will be placed on the Waiting List.

Results of the Ballot will be available from Mrs Dianne Cree on Monday 15th February, 2010. You have one month to return the required deposit confirming your booking. Deposits for all three lodges are approximately one half of the weekly Winter Tariff, based on the bunk rate.

EXACT ROOM ALLOCATIONS AND COST WILL BE ADVISED ONE WEEK BEFORE DEPARTURE.

During school holidays in July and September, all accommodation must be utilised to the maximum. Spare beds in rooms cannot be left unoccupied and usually children and parents must share the same room.

Note: It is essential to nominate 3 alternate preferences for accommodation.
